

The Loyalty of Joan of Arc.


The moon illuminates a village in France.

She asks her mother how she can overcome her fears and be loyal, her mother answers her "you have to write your feelings in a notebook and these become true.




she starts to write her emotions in a notebook, and she notices that it really works.

She continues to write in her notebook and she begins to wish to be a warrior.






One day already old, she celebrates years and wishes to become a warrior of the king.

When she talks with the king, she tells him her adventures, the king interrupts her.




The king gives her the post of commander of the royal army, because she demonstrates her loyalty to him.




She accepts that post and cuts her hair to continues to show her loyalty to her king and her people.
